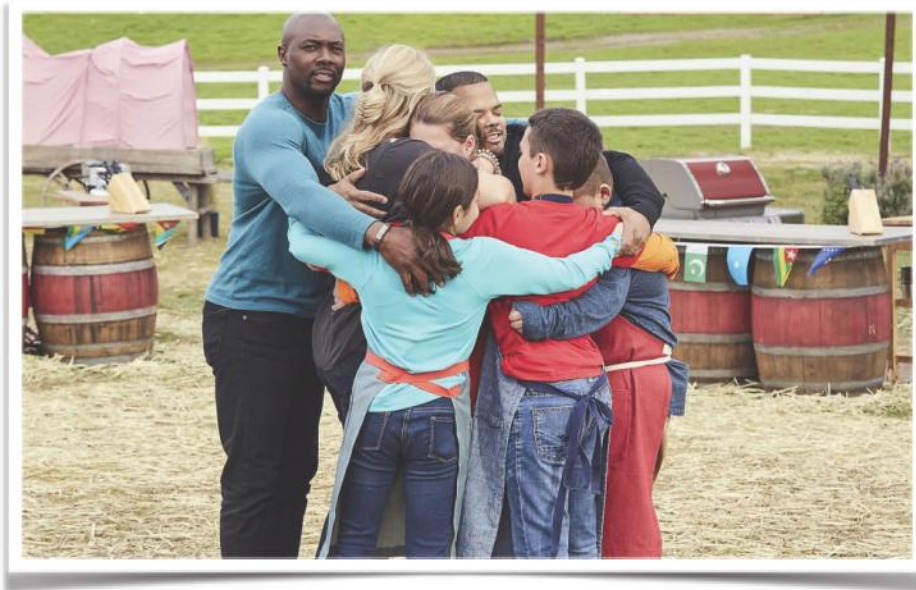


# Children's Village

## Program Expectations

At Christian City Children’s Village, the natural families partner closely with a support team designed to ensure the family and child’s needs are met. The team consists of human service professionals, therapists, house parents, and the program executive. Families in our program are expected to participate in service planning, therapy, visitation and recommended trainings. Families are asked to provide financial support on a sliding scale, no family is denied services due to financial limitations.

## Educational Provisions

A strong emphasis is placed on each child’s educational needs being met. Children often enter the program 1-2 grade levels behind. The program strives to catch children up to the proper grade level with various academic supports. CCCV partners with public and private accredited schools in the community to meet educational needs. The program boasts a 100% high school graduation rate for youth that remain in the program.

Our program is designed to work with the family through partnership parenting with the natural family and house parents by equipping the youth and natural family with skills needed to thrive upon completion of the program.

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
