Graceland celebrates its 40th birthday this spring so it seems the perfect time to remember the importance of the thrift store is the mission of Christian City. The store exists to raise

children and families. This year, Graceland

is expected to exceed its project profits of \$45,000! That's a lot for a shop that is run almost entirely by volunteers.

Graceland has one full time staff member, Michelle Gardner, who manages everything with three part-time staffers. Together they sort, classify, price and stage every single item that is donated. Another way to think of it is that every item donated has been "touched" by a staff member or volunteer FOUR times before it is purchased - then, of course, it is "touched" again at check out. On average, between 200-300 customers visit Graceland each month purchasing 200 pieces of clothing or other items every day the shop is open! "We strive to keep our items at a reasonable price for our customers," Michelle said.

In May 1984, retired houseparent Grace Dukes began having Saturday yard sales to benefit the Children's Village. Everything was 25 cents. It wasn't long before a storefront was envisioned. Truett Cathy, founder of Chick-fil-A, was

volunteering one day, and realized a building was needed. A phone call later, the building that now sits on our campus was conceived.

Lots of people think Graceland is named after that famous home in Memphis. In fact, Graceland is named in honor of its founder Mama Grace for her love of the kids and support of the ministry of Christian City. "Today we still run Graceland like Mama Grace did, with a heart for people, and all of our proceeds go to help our children in the Children's Village," Michelle said.

Graceland is open for shopping Tuesday, Thursday and

Saturday from 9:30 am until 2:30 pm. The rest of the week is for processing donations of every sort. If you haven't visited Graceland, be sure to drop by and say hi to Michelle, And Graceland can always use



### TRANSPORTATION HELP

Christian City received a grant again from the Catholic Foundation of North Georgia to provide assistance to seniors for transportation to medical appointments. ALL Christian City independent living residents are eligible to participate in this program. Beginning January 1, Christian City will reimburse up to \$100 a month for qualifying medical transport. This can be an Uber/Lyft to a doctor's appointment, medical transport to dialysis, reimbursement for mileage driven in your personal vehicle, etc.

To receive reimbursement, contact your Service Coordinator (apartments) or Tyler Garcia (patio homes). Receipts and demographic information will be collected. This is available until grant funds run out. Contact Tyler Garcia at 770-703-2730 with questions.
