


Medical Appointments Now Available on Campus!

The 2025 **Count Me In** fundraising campaign runs through February 14. Our goal this year is to raise \$15,000 to replace the walk-in freezer at the Children's Village food pantry. The freezer is crucial because it allows us to accept donations of meat and other cold foods to feed the children in our programs.

Count Me In gives residents and Christian City staff the opportunity to come together to raise money for a particular project on campus while supporting the Children & Family Program. In the past the campaign has funded sound mitigation in the Rec Center, updating the Children's Village training room and adding benches around campus.

Your neighborhood CMI captain will deliver information and pledge cards over the next few days. We encourage you to prayerfully consider donating to the campaign and even becoming a monthly donor if you are able! Our GEMs (Gives Every Month) are an important part of our donor base, knowing that we can count on that consistent monthly gift is a blessing!

We're also continuing our Chip In monthly donations drives. Donate items to help Christian City programs and receive a chip. Collect your chips through 2025 to cash in for fun prizes or put toward the grand prize raffle. This year the winner will choose between a 2- day stay at Callaway Gardens or two meals a week in the cafeteria for a year.


