- and more!



#### HAPPENING AT TWO SPARROWS VILLAGE

Did you know that Americans with disabilities have a significantly higher obesity rate than the typical American? Within the IDD (Intellectual and Developmental Difference) population, inactivity, limited access to healthy foods, lack of knowledge, and poor diet contribute to weight gain and its causal health challenges.

The residents and participants at Two Sparrows Village don't accept these odds sitting down. The staff and support of Christian City provide an active, healthy lifestyle. In March



the residents will enjoy fitness center outings, dance and culinary classes, workouts with professional fitness instructors, Chair One fitness, and yoga with our resident's concierge Jana Realbuto.

In addition to these activities, well-planned grocery outings are a part of the residents' weekly duties. They are learning how nature packs

fresh, whole foods with macro and micronutrients while processed foods are packed with sugar, sodium, preservatives, and additives. If you need some tips for healthy meals on a budget, we've got you covered!

Two Sparrows Village at Christian City is a pilot independent living program for adults with IDD. It now includes a day program as well as the original residentic



well as the original residential program.

#### HAPPENING IN THRIVE

Asia had been in and out of foster care for years before finding herself homeless and living on the streets. Wanting to turn her life around, she applied for the Thrive program in 2023. The referral and background check process were not favorable. She had stolen food – more than once. Vasheta Prather, our Thrive program manager, met with her. Asia was desperate. She needed a safe place to live and get her life together.

Vasheta listened as Asia told her story and spoke about her desire for a different life. Vasheta said a prayer and accepted Asia into the program in December 2023. Since then, she has completed her high school diploma, obtained her driver's license and a forklift certification, and secured a permanent full-time job. In January, she received her second work promotion.

Asia is a very hard worker and a determined young woman. Her "unfavorable" background was the result of being a kid on her own, living on the streets and trying to survive. Since Vasheta welcomed her into our program, she has been a joy to watch as she grows and, yes, thrives.

Thrive is a program of the Christian City Children and Family team. It helps homeless young adults, 18-24 years old, successfully launch into adult life.
